In writing, numbers are used to communicate a variety of information. This includes currency, dates, percentages, and order of importance. Although there is no standard for using numbers in all styles of writing, here are some general guidelines.

## Spell out:

Numbers between zero and nine
Indefinite amounts
General time periods
Common fractions
Universally accepted usage
Fractions less than one

> millions of people, over one billion the Sixties, the fifteenth century
> one-fifth of the class, a two-thirds majority the Twelve Apostles, the Five Pillars of Islam two-thirds, nine-tenths

Decimals
Divisions in books
Addresses
Specific dates
Fractions greater than one
Numbers 10 and up

## Exceptions to these rules:

Use numerals when grouping a number between zero and nine with a larger number.

- Example: Only $\mathbf{8}$ out of $\mathbf{4 0}$ people attended the meeting today.

Use numerals when writing a precise measurement or mathematical function.

- Examples: $\mathbf{4} \mathrm{cm}$ wide, the remaining $\mathbf{7 \%}$, the $\mathbf{9}_{\text {th }}$ trial, a ratio of 16:1

Spell out numbers that begin a sentence, title, or text heading.

- Example: Forty-eight out of $\mathbf{7 0}$ people voted for the bylaw.
